The **DESIGN** tab allows you to select from several attractive design templates.



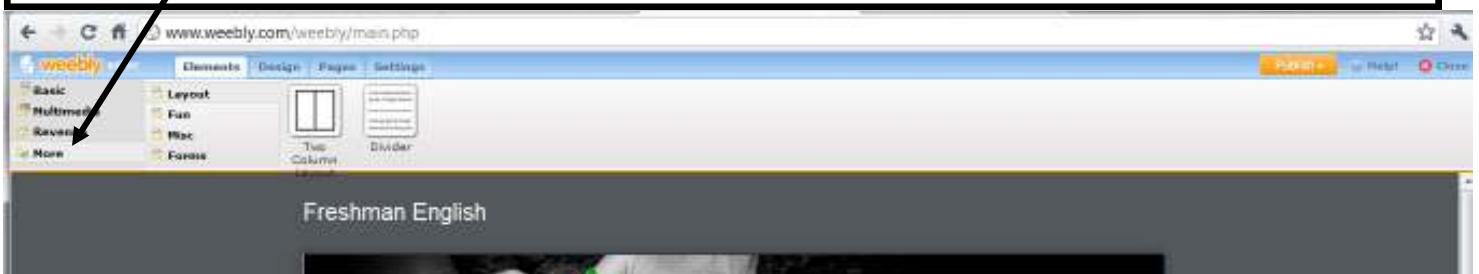
The **ELEMENTS** tab allows you to select basic “pieces” to build the overall structure of your website. Just **drag and drop** items onto your page.



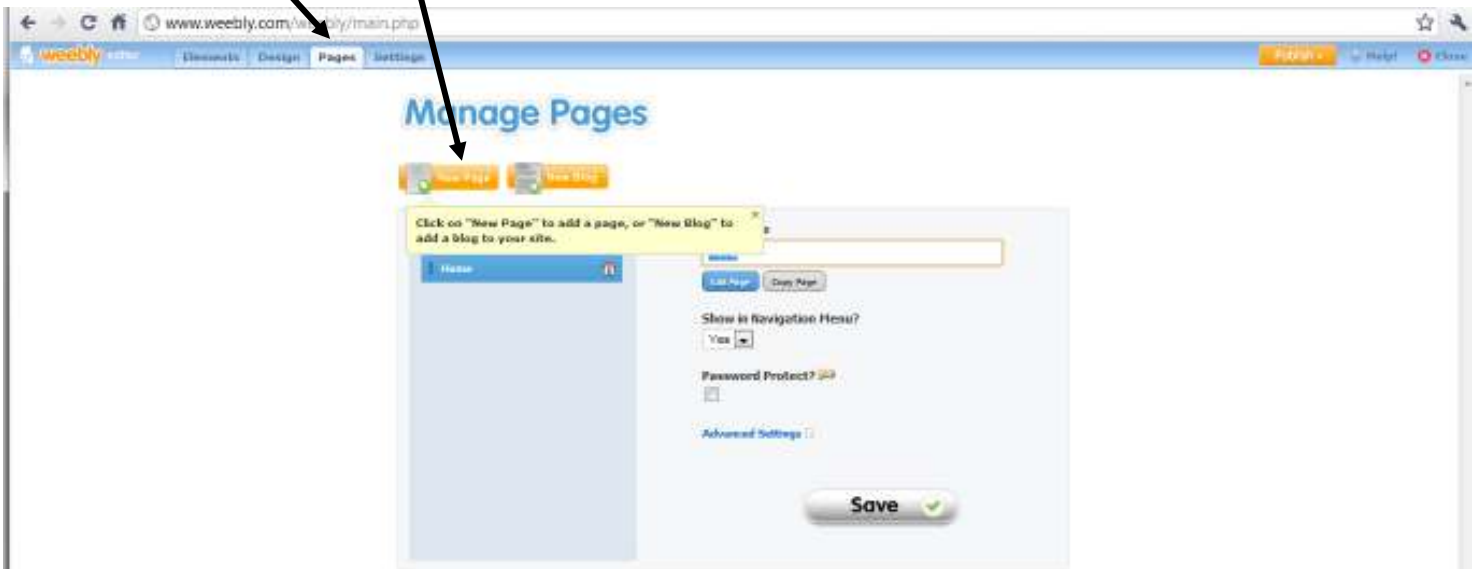
In addition to **Basic** elements, you can also select from **Multimedia** elements to add items such as a photo gallery or You Tube video. Items marked **Pro** required paid membership.



Under the **MORE** tab, you can also use a Two-Column Layout or insert a line Divider.

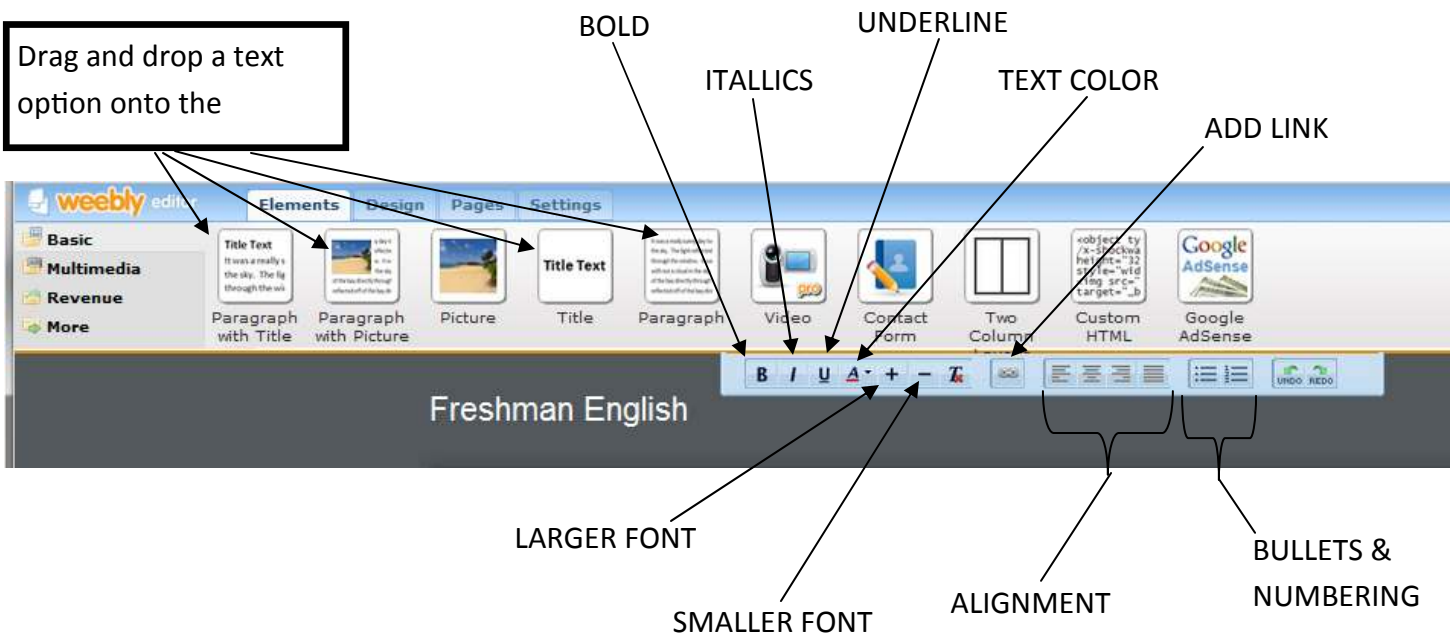

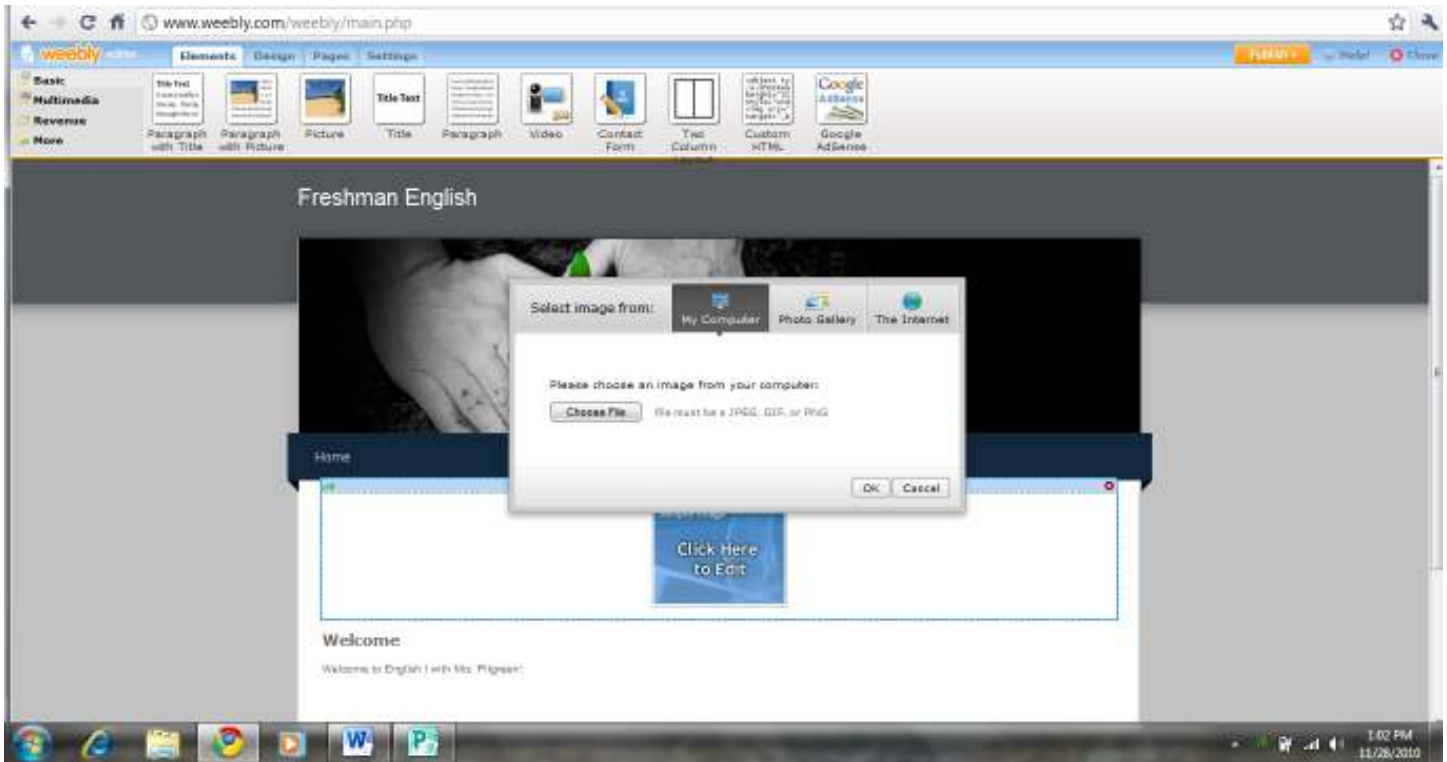


FORMATTING A TEXT BOX
